Karyn brings her lived experience as a caregiver for family members who live with mental health challenges.

Karyn retired from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, St. Louis Division in December 2017, where she served as a Special Agent for approximately 23 years specializing in narcotic, money laundering, and criminal enterprise investigations. Karyn spent her last three years spear-heading mental health training for Special Agents, professional support, and federal, state, and local partners by providing opportunities for training through MHFA, CIT, and coordinating community speakers. Karyn consulted on the development of mental health curriculum within the FBI and established FBI St. Louis' membership in the St. Louis Crisis Intervention Coordinating Council led by St. Louis County Police Department and the St. Louis National Alliance on Mental Health, Community Policing Unit. Prior to her career with the FBI, Karyn was a Deputy United States Marshal, United States Marshals Service.
